## SACC University

SACC University is an entry level training to orient staff to the out-of school time field. This professional development opportunity will provide new staff with strategies they can use immediately in their work with 5-12 year olds.



### **September 14, 2010– SACC University: Safety & Promoting Healthy Lifestyles in School Age Care (Part 1 of 5)**

Participants will learn how to set up healthy safe learning environment for school-age children. They will employ effective supervision to keep children safe and plan for individual differences. Learn strategies to incorporate wellness, and fitness activities that promote healthy youth. K7C1-76.

**September 21, 2010– SACC University: Managing the Environment Not the Child (Part 2 of 5)** Participants will learn about the developmental characteristics of children ages 5-12. Participants will learn strategies for guiding, managing, and supervising school-age children's activities. K2C1-21.

### **September 28, 2010– SACC University: Putting Kids at the Center: Youth Choice and Voice (Part 3 of 5)**

Participants will learn how to plan activities that engage youth, incorporate the learning standards, and involve youth in planning and making decisions about the daily program activities. K2C1-11.

**October 5, 2010– SACC University: Relationships (Part 4 of 5)** Participants will explore strategies that promote positive relationships within an inclusive, diversity-rich school age program. Learn how to building relationships with the child, the family, co-workers, and community. K3C1-31.

**October 12, 2010– SACC University: Professionalism (Part 5 of 5)** The participant will learn to: (1) identify examples of professional and unprofessional behavior based on the National Afterschool Association Code of Ethics, (2) explore professional development, career planning, and the Pennsylvania Career Lattice. K6C1-62.
